Re: Keyin College Return to Campus Under Alert Level 4

Date: March 3, 2021

We want to provide you with the latest guidelines and protocol for those of you returning to Keyin College Campuses outside of the Avalon Region under the Alert Level 4 System. These daily practices will help keep you, your classmates, staff members, families, and community safe.

Minimize Contact/Social Distancing: As per Chief Medical Officer of Health's recommendations, students and staff should maintain a physical distance of at least 2 meters (6 feet) while attending our campuses. This includes both seated and standing activities.

Use of Masks: While attending our campuses all individuals must wear a non-medical mask. When seated in classrooms, masks can only be removed when physical distancing of 6 feet can be maintained. However, Public Health recommends wearing a non-medical mask as much as possible, even when seated. Instructors should wear a Level 1 mask and eye protection at all times when in close contact with students.

Daily Covid-19 Screening: Remember if you are not feeling well, please stay home. All students and staff should review the Covid-19 symptoms and treatment list which can be found at <https://www.gov.nl.ca/covid-19/covid-19-symptoms-treatment/>. If any student or staff member has any of the Covid-19 symptoms, they are not permitted to enter our campuses.

Hand Washing and Sanitizing: Continue to implement good hygiene techniques including washing of hands and regular use of hand sanitizer.

Non-essential Areas: All non-essential areas within our campuses will be closed in order to reduce gatherings and the number of surfaces where infection can be transmitted.
