Technology Trainer and Support (TTS) Position is designed to support persons with disabilities facing barriers to social isolation due to covid-19 pandemic. Through this project the TTS is responsible to train, offer support and online workshops for individuals who have cross disabilities, and to ensure that they are supported and trained to overcome barriers to social isolation.

As an TTS, you would be responsible for the following Duties:

- Training and supporting clients on using their technology to break down barriers of social isolation
- Create training plans/materials for people with disabilities
- Assist people with assistive technology (AT) and strategies on devices
- Work one-on-one and groups to develop online skills
- Assist with device troubleshooting
- Prepare and deliver technology workshops to small groups, as needed
- Promote the awareness, value, and use of AT.
- Perform additional duties as may be assigned.

Qualifications:

The ideal candidate should have:

- Experience with Devices – in particular, Windows, Chrome & MAC Operating Systems, Internet and Email applications; Microsoft Office or Equivalent.
- Experience in training and basic troubleshooting
- An understanding of the philosophy of Independent Living;
- Knowledge of Assistive Technology, a definite asset
